- · Smart School technology: I.T. and web-based platform assisting teachers and students





The International Baccalaureate (IB) is an international qualification which offers university preparation through a rigorous academic programme. The IB Diploma is recognized and accepted by the most competitive universities in the UK, US, and around the world.

Our international track students study six subjects: three at higher level and three at standard level. The compulsory DP core is comprised of the Extended Essay (EE), Theory of Knowledge (TOK), and Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS) elements.

GAFL's first year (PreDP) students follow an internally designed IBDP preparatory curriculum and fulfill national curriculum elements including extra-curricular activities. All of our IB students receive a Korean high school diploma upon successful graduation.
