Oratory 4-6 minutes original speech, persuasive in nature. No notes.
After-Dinner 4-6 minutes original speech, humorous in nature. No notes.
Interp Reading 4-6 minutes dramatic reading. Little movement. Bring your script.
Debate Parliamentary impromptu 6-6-8-8-2-2 times. Almanac allowed.
Impromptu Random topic, 2 minutes prep, 3-5 minutes speaking. No notes.

Competitors Note:

World Individuals requires low preparation but high speaking ability and varied skill sets. You deliver speeches twice.

Rounds 1 & 2: Speaking

You must come with a prepared 5-minute speech--persuasive or humorous.

Rounds 3 & 4: Drama

You must perform a prepared reading (interpretation) with a script you bring.

Rounds 5 & 6: Debate

Partnering is random and the debate is impromptu. Each team may use one paper dictionary and one paper almanac--neither provided by host.

Round 7: Impromptu (Finals)

Top speakers based on first six rounds

Coaches Note:

Coaches will meet during lunch. Top items for discussion: future Korea Forensics League events and communication.

Judges Note:

Judges give written & oral feedback. Judges keep time. See times below. 1-3 students = 1 judge, 4-6 = 2 judges, 7-9 = 3 judges.
